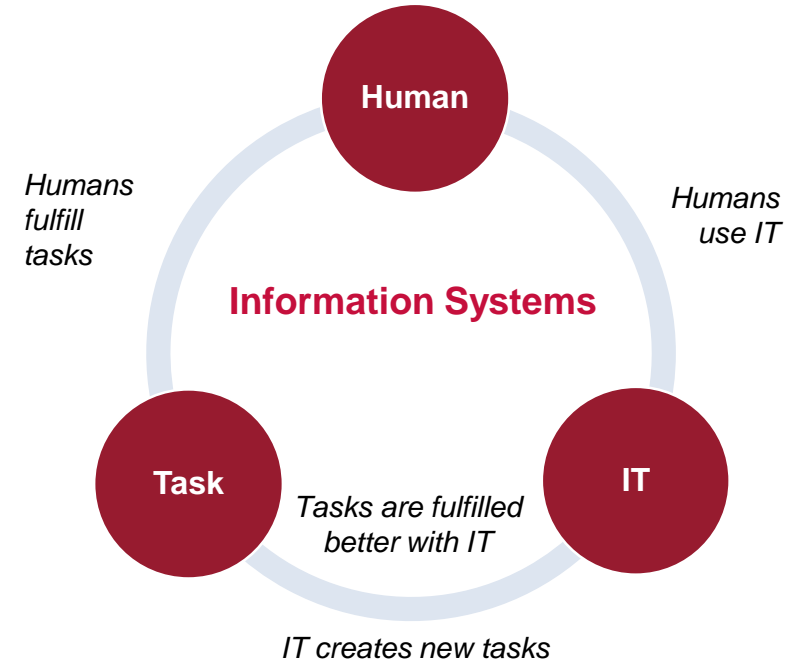
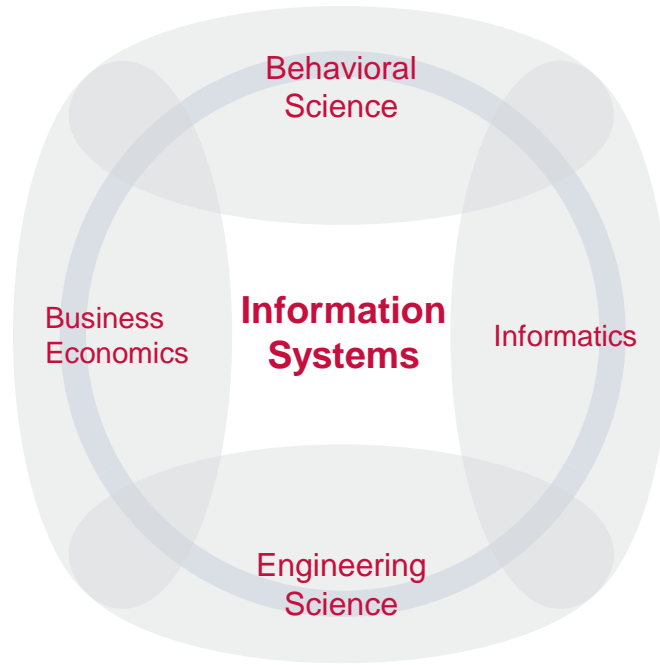

The Master IIS offers students the opportunity to acquire in-depth methodological knowledge

Degree: Master of Science

Standard period of study: 4 terms (2 years)

Start: Winter term

Language: English and German

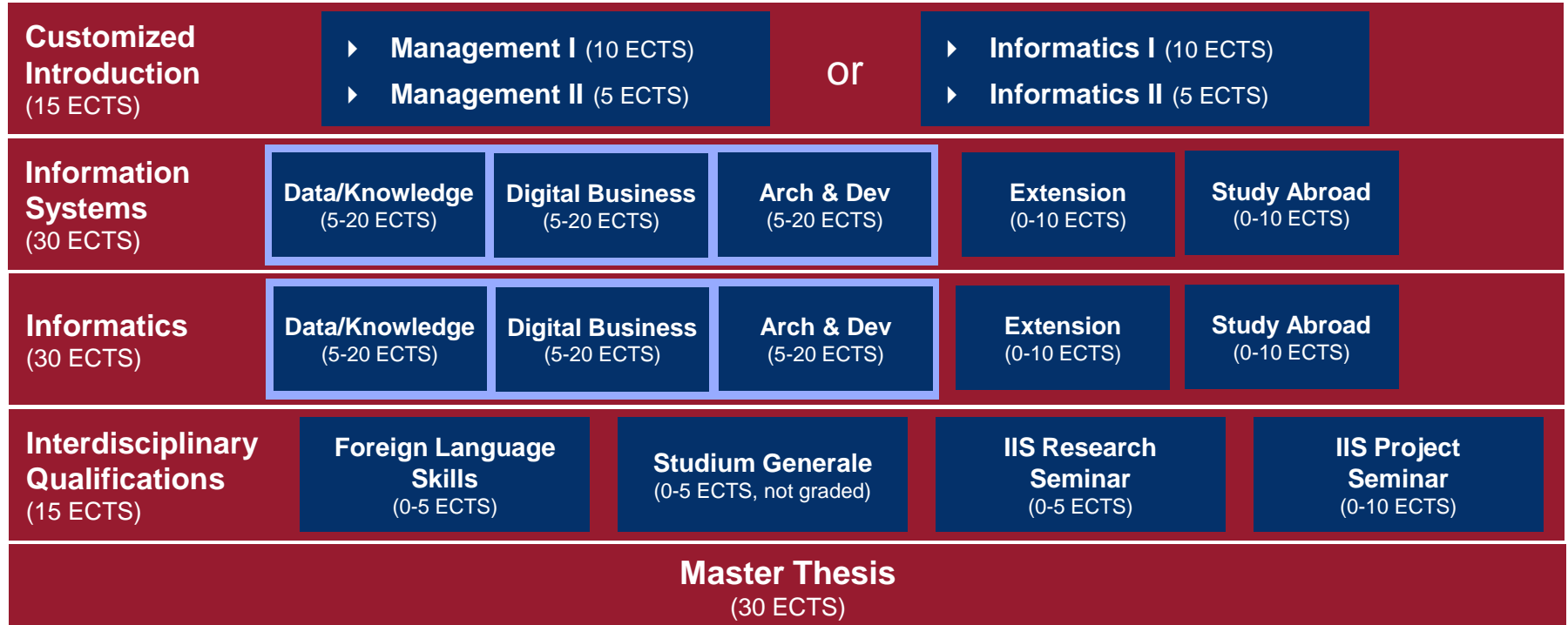
Special characteristics

- ❖ Great flexibility in the choice of modules
- ❖ High degree of internationalization
- ❖ Mandatory semester abroad
- ❖ Individual focus on specific topics



Structure of the study program

The Information Systems program has a duration of four semesters and comprises 120 ECTS



In order to broaden their international understanding, students must gain international experience



Note that the semester abroad remains **mandatory**, however, students that completed their **entire Bachelor/Master degree** in a university located in a country where German is not an official language have the possibility to be **exempt** from the obligation to spend a mandatory semester abroad.

Four different options:

Option A:

Exchange semester with a **partner university**

Option B:

Exchange semester to any university as a **free mover**

Option C:

Writing the **master thesis** with an **academic partner abroad**

Option D:

Writing the **master thesis** at a **company abroad**

Options for Master Thesis

The Master Thesis is written over a period of six months and completes the study program

Master Thesis

30 ECTS

Option 1

- Writing at **FAU** with a **university chair**

OR

Option 2

- Writing at **FAU** in cooperation with a **company in Germany**

OR

Option 3

- Writing with an **academic partner abroad** *(counts as semester abroad)*

OR

Option 4

- Writing at a **company abroad** *(counts as semester abroad)*

We are looking forward to receiving your applications

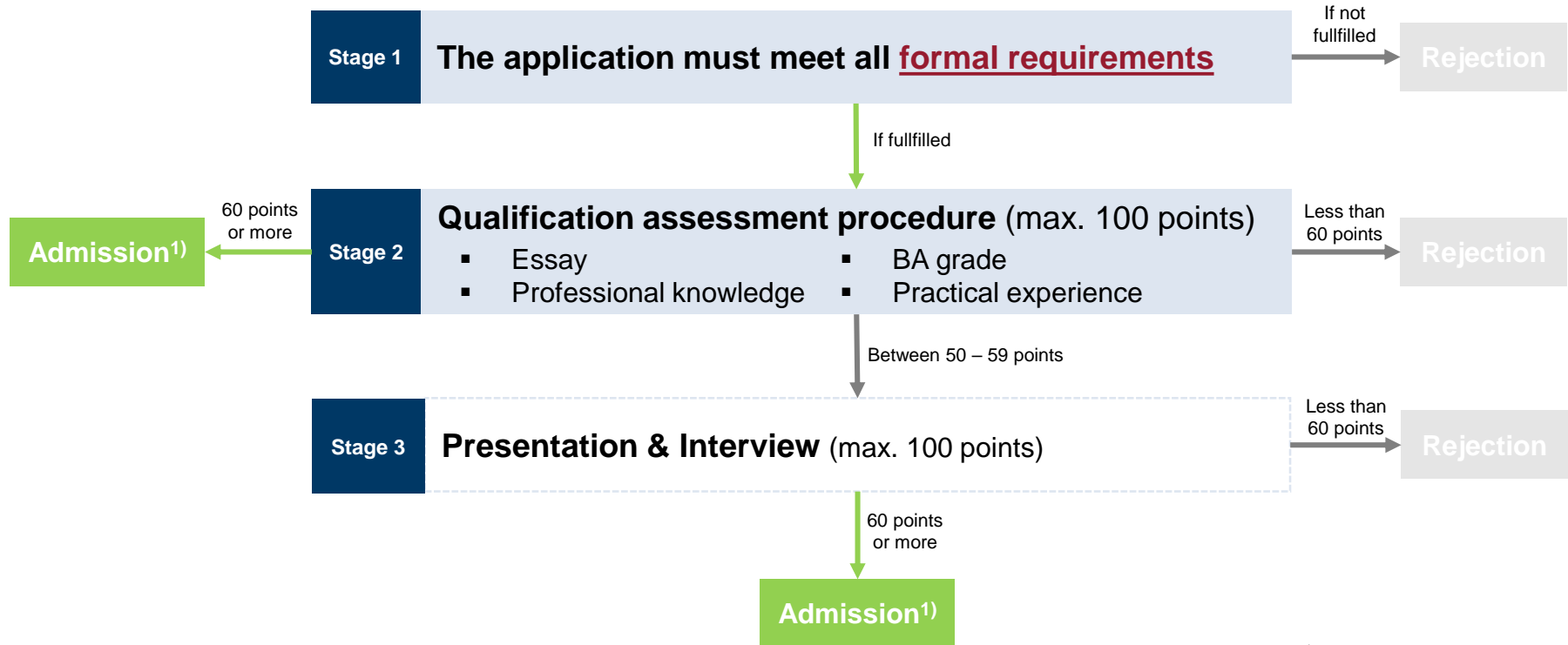
Application for the Master's program in International Information Systems is open for students who have successfully completed an **undergraduate degree**, preferably with a focus on **Business** or **IT** (although other academic backgrounds may also be considered). The program starts every **winter semester**.

The **application period** for the winter term 2023/24 **opens on April 13, 2023** and **closes on May 31, 2023**. The entire **application process** below needs to be completed until this deadline. This includes the following **steps**:

Assessment of your application by the selection committee

The assessment is structured in three steps

Stage 1: Formal requirements

Students must meet the formal requirements for a further evaluation of the application

Bachelor degree

- As well as comparable degree programs at other universities, e.g. Business Administration, Information Systems, or Computer Science

Further documents and certificates

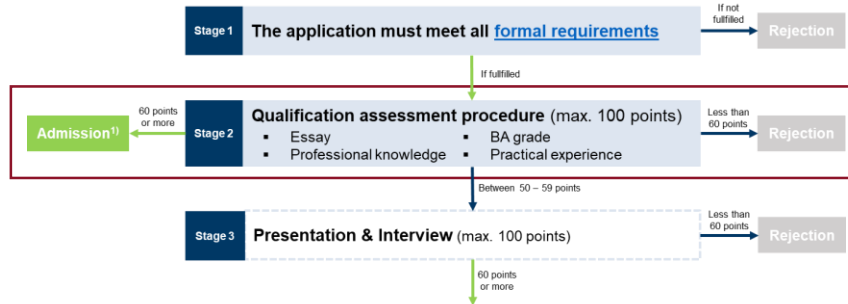
Which documents do we need further?

1. Essay (max. 1,000 words)
2. English certificate C1 (e.g. TOEFL iBT 95, UNICERT III, Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE), Cambridge English Proficiency (CPE), or IELTS 7.0)
3. German certificate A2 (e.g. Goethe Zertifikat A2, DSH 1, TestDaF 3)
4. Evidence of the scope and quality of your other skills, knowledge and soft skills (e.g. study abroad, internships)

Stage 2: How are the points evaluated in the second stage?

The evaluation of stage 2 is explained in the IIS examination regulations



Quality of the previous degree or performance on the basis of the average grade

Max. 40 points

Knowledge of business, economics, informatics, and information systems, assessed on the basis of the modules taken in the bachelor

Max. 45 points

Quality of the Essay

Max. 5 points

Extent and duration of relevant professional work experience

Max. 10 points

= max. 100 points
