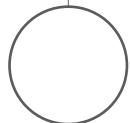

After the end of the application period, the last applications are currently being reviewed

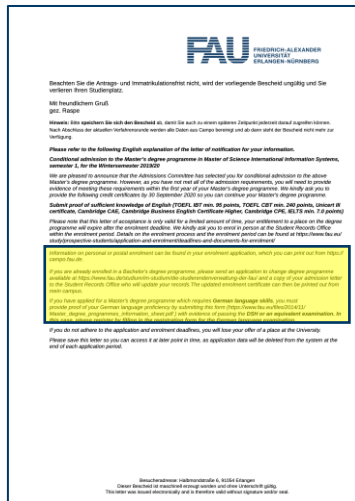
Status Quo

- **Application period for winter term 2023/24 closed on May 31, 2023**
 - All required documents must have reached us both online and offline
- **Applications are collected, screened and evaluated**
 - Assessment of application based on formal and qualification requirements
- **Admission letters are issued and sent to admitted persons**
 - After careful examination of the application, admission or rejection letters are sent out
- **Matriculation can be requested with admission letter**
 - Status in campo changes and the instructions for enrollment must be followed

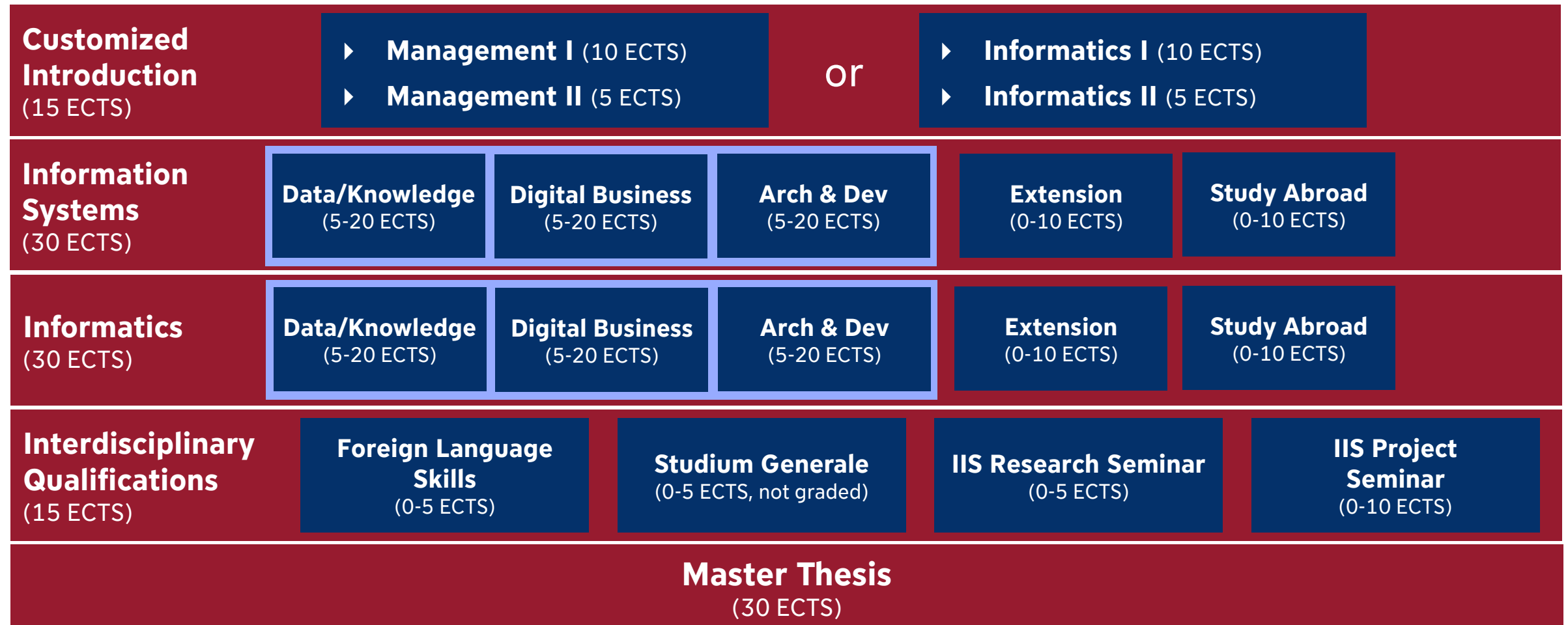

Studying abroad

In order to broaden their international understanding, students must gain international experience

Four different options:

Option A:

Exchange semester with a **partner university**

Option B:

Exchange semester to any university as a **free mover**

Option C:

Writing the **master thesis** with an **academic partner abroad**

Option D:

Writing the **master thesis** at a **company abroad**

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Location Map

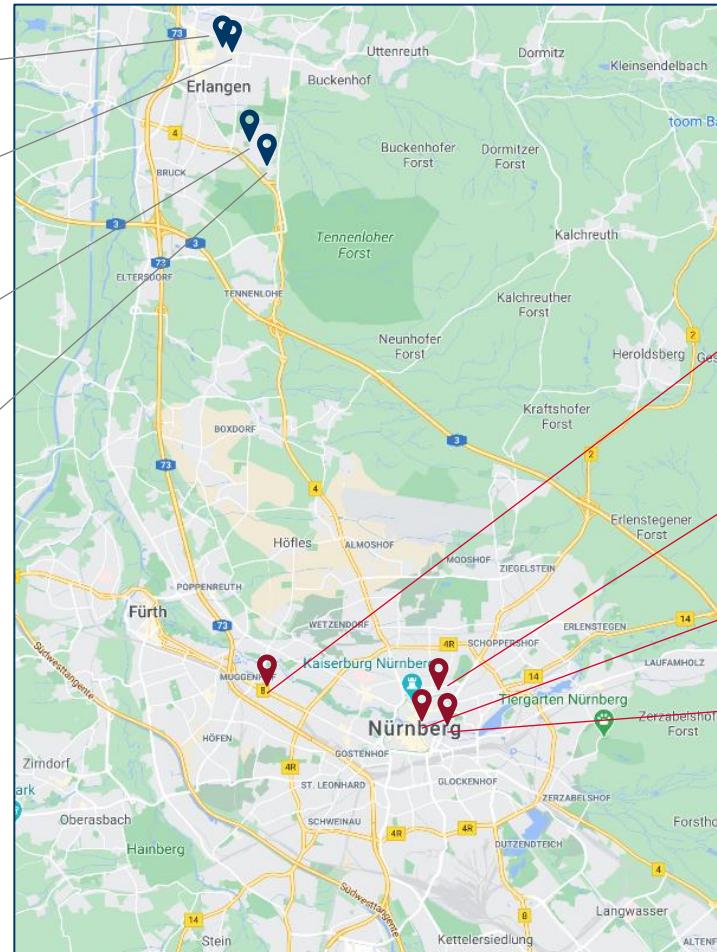
